*La principal novedad de esta Historia de la Música es que cada uno de sus 6 libros se centra en un tema concreto. De este modo, al individualizar cada tema, se puede tener una visión comparada a través del tiempo, perspectiva que se pierde cuando se tratan todos los temas a la vez en una misma época. Cada libro o bloque se divide en 9 épocas. Este segundo bloque, Géneros musicales, estudia los siguientes aspectos: • Función religiosa o profana de los principales géneros que se cultivan en cada época. • Características propias de cada género musical: estructura, textura, instrumentación, tipo de texto (si lo hay), etc. Su evolución. • Principales compositores y obras de cada género. El libro se acompaña de un CD-ROM en el que hay 573 audiciones (fragmentos), 154 partituras que se corresponden con otras tantas audiciones y 258 imágenes (danzas, escenografías de óperas, escenas, carteles de conciertos, etc.), todo ello comentado en el libro, incluyendo los textos y su traducción. Estas audiciones, partituras e imágenes sirven de ilustración al contenido teórico. También se incluye en el CD-ROM una bibliografía comentada, enlaces seleccionados y comentados a páginas web y una lista de las 573 audiciones (título, autor, fecha de composición, intérpretes, sello, año de grabación, etc.). El objetivo principal ha sido crear un material de consulta para estudios universitarios de Musicología y para estudios en Conservatorios Superiores de Música, aunque también puede ser de interés y utilidad para profesionales de la música y melómanos en general.*

*Analysing over 100 recordings from 1945-1975, this book examines twentieth-century baroque performance practice as evinced in all the commercially available recordings of J.S. Bach's Passions, Brandenburg Concertos and Goldberg Variations. Dorottya Fabian presents a qualitative, style-orientated history of the early music movement in its formative years through a comparison of the performance style heard in these recordings with the scholarly literature on Bach performance practice. Issues explored in the book include the availability of resources, balance, tempo, dynamics, ornamentation, rhythm and articulation. During the decades following the Second World War, the early music movement was more concerned with the revival of repertoire than with the revival of performance style which meant that its characteristics and achievements differed essentially from those of the later 1970s and 1980s. Period practice techniques were not practised even by ensembles using eighteenth-century instruments. Yet, as this survey reveals, several recordings of the period provide unexpectedly stylish interpretations using metre and pulse to punctuate the music. Such metric performance and appropriate articulation helped to clarify structure and texture and assisted in the creation of a musical discourse - the pre-eminent goal of baroque compositions.*

Students, teachers and professional pianists will find this volume invaluable. This historically accurate edition contains a wealth of background information on ornamentation, dotted rhythms in the Baroque style, and the recommended tempos and guidelines for performing the works on the piano. Bach's writing is carefully separated from the editorial suggestions in light gray print. A wealth of footnotes compare the various sources consulted.

This is the first comprehensive study of the trombone in English. It covers the instrument, its repertoire, the way it has been played, and the social, cultural, and aesthetic contexts within which it has developed. The book explores the origins of the instrument, its invention in the fifteenth century, and its story up to modern times, also revealing hidden aspects of the trombone in different eras and countries. The book looks not only at the trombone within classical music but also at its place in jazz, popular music, popular religion, and light music. Trevor Herbert examines each century of the trombone's development and details the fundamental impact of jazz on the modern trombone. By the late twentieth century, he shows, jazz techniques had filtered into the performance idioms of almost all styles of music and transformed ideas about virtuosity and lyricism in trombone playing.

In this volume, which contains six suites and seven supplementary pieces for intermediate to advanced level pianists, Judith Schneider has provided detailed biographical and historical information about the pieces, as well as suggestions to achieve a proper interpretation of these works. Bach's table of ornaments is also discussed. This volume

beautifully prepares students to perform Bach's more advanced English Suites.

*This edition of the Bach Cello Suites is appealing to both the scholar and the performer. The genesis of this edition was the alignment of the relevant manuscripts for easy comparison and study using a line-by-line layout. It has resulted in the ultimate scholarly approach to the study of these manuscripts and has led to many discoveries concerning notes, trills, dots, dynamics, and rhythm. In the scordatura version of "Suite No. 5," pitch names are given above the notes for the re-tuned top string, clarifying confusing elements in the notation. Fingerings and bowings in this edition reflect those used on the DVD set of Starkweather's performance of the suites (item number 730150). Reference to the manuscript edition makes it possible to visually assess the ambiguity of many of the slurs and to reach one's own conclusions.*

Revisiting Music Theory: A Guide to the Practice contains the basics of music theory with the vocabulary used in harmonic and formal analysis. The book assumes few music reading skills, and progresses to include the basic materials of music from J. S. Bach to the twentieth century. Based on Blatter's own three decades of teaching music theory, this book is aimed at a one or two year introductory course in music theory, can serve for individual study, or as a review for graduate students returning to school. Drawing examples from well-known classical works, as well as folk and popular music, the book shows how theory is applied to practice. The book is divided into five parts. The first part introduces music notation, reviewing the basics of pitch, time, and dynamics as represented in written music. Part 2 introduces the concept of melody, covering modes, scales, scale degrees, and melodic form. Part 3 introduces harmony, dealing with harmonic progression, rhythm, and chord types. Part 4 addresses part writing and harmonic analysis. Finally, Part 5 addresses musical form, and how form is used to structure a

composition. Revisiting Music Theory will be a valuable textbook for students, professors, and professionals.

**What is a sonata? Literally translated, it simply means 'instrumental piece'.
