Sure, she's a pro and he's one of her show's judges, but they're not currently filming, so no one needs to know. Living in close quarters shows Dimitri a side of Natasha he's never seen before, and he likes it. A lot. Too bad she's doing everything in her power to keep him at arm's length. When an injury forces Natasha to take it easy or risk her ability to dance, it's his chance to show her that the rules have changed, and she can trust him with her heart.
