And that's an important difference, if you believe, as I do, that those stories contain something essential about who we are and who God is." Good storytelling, he explains, comes from blending your own passion, wit, and creativity with skill. work - How to take a Bible story to pieces, and recast it to compel the listener's attention

There may be times when reading a story is not possible, like while driving a car or walking through a store. That's when the story can be told using your own creative adaptations.
