Networking means to create nets of relations, where the publisher and the reader, the artist and the audience, act on the same level. The book is a first tentative reconstruction of the history of artistic networking in Italy, through an analysis of media and art projects which during the past twenty years have given way to a creative, shared and aware use of technologies, from video to computers, contributing to the creation of Italian hacker communities. The Italian network proposes a form of critical information, disseminated through independent and collective projects where the idea of freedom of expression is a central theme. In Italy, thanks to the alternative use of Internet, during the past twenty years a vast national network of people who share political, cultural and artistic views has been formed. The book describes the evolution of the Italian hacktivism and net culture from the 1980s till today. It builds a reflection on the new role of the artist and author who becomes a networker, operating in collective nets, reconnecting to Neoavant-garde practices of the 1960s (first and foremost Fluxus), but also Mail Art, Neoism and Luther Blissett. A path which began in BBSes, alternative web platforms spread in Italy through the 1980s even before the Internet even existed, and then moved on to Hackmeetings, to Telestreet and networking art by different artists such as 0100101110101101.ORG, [epidemiC], Jaromil, Giacomo Verde, Giovanotti Mondani Meccanici, Correnti Magnetiche, Candida TV, Tommaso Tozzi, Federico Bucalossi, Massimo Contrasto, Mariano Equizzi, Pigreca, Molleindustria, Guerriglia Marketing, Sexyshock, Phag Off and many others.

An American Demon is Jack Grisham's story of depravity and

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redemption, terror and spiritual deliverance. While Grisham is best known as the raucous and provocative front man of the pioneer hardcore punk band TSOL (True Sounds of Liberty), his writing and true life experiences are physically and psychologically more complex, unsettling, and violent than those of Bret Easton Ellis and Chuck Palahniuk. Eloquently disregarding the prefabricated formulas of the drunk'to'sober, bad'to'good tale, this is an entirely new kind of life lesson: summoned through both God and demons, while settling within eighties hardcore punk culture and its radical'to'the'core (and most assuredly non'evangelical) parables, Grisham leads us, cleverly, gorgeously, between temporal violence and bigger-picture spirituality toward something very much like a path to salvation and enlightenment. An American Demon flourishes on both extremes, as a scary hardcore punk memoir and as a valuable message to souls navigating through an overly materialistic and woefully self'absorbed "me first" modern society. An American Demon conveys anger and truth within the perfect setting, using a youth rebellion that changed the world to open doors for this level of brash destruction. Told from the point of view of a seminal member of the American Punk movement 'doused in violence, rebellion, alcoholism, drug abuse, and ending with beautiful lessons of sobriety and absolution 'this book is as harrowing and life'affirming as anything you're ever going to read. During the 1960s and 1970s, magazines became an important new site of artistic practice, functioning as an alternative exhibition space for the dematerialized practices of conceptual art. Allen looks at the most important of these magazines in their heyday and compiles an illustrated directory of hundreds of others.

La moda

Taken in the streets, clubs, basements and bars of London between 1978 and 1987, the photographs in "78-87 London Youth" celebrate the many mutations in London's youth culture from the height of punk to the birth of Acid House. British photographer Derek Ridgers has documented the perennial youth ritual of dressing up and going out since he first picked up a camera in 1971, and has been drawn to virtually every subculture London has spawned, from punk to the fetish club scene of the present. From early on his photographs attracted the attention of both cultural institutions such as London's ICA and music and style publications such as the "NME" and "The Face." These photographs, made over a ten-year span, capture punk's evolution into goth, the skinhead revival and the New Romantic scene, and the eventual emergence of Acid House and the new psychedelia. Gathered here, Ridgers' images

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serve not only as a fascinating document of UK style and culture but as a testament to the creative spirit of youth; he lauds his subjects and their sartorial DIY panache. Among those portrayed are Boy George, Andrew Logan, Leigh Bowery and his boyfriend Trojan, Michael Alig, John Galliano, Hamish Bowles, Cerith Wyn Evans, Steve Strange and Martin Kemp and Steve Norman of Spandau Ballet. Derek Ridgers (born 1950) is an English photographer with a career spanning more than 30 years. He is best known for his photography of music, film, club and street culture, and has photographed stars from James Brown to The Spice Girls, from Clint Eastwood to Johnny Depp, as well politicians, gangsters, artists, writers, fashion designers and sportsmen.

Mario Puzo may have written the book and Coppola may have made the film about mafia, but only Letizia Battaglia told the real story; the plain, harsh story. Letizia Battaglia (Palermo, 1935) is a Sicilian photographer and photojournalist. Although her photos document a wide spectrum of Sicilian life, she is best known for her work on the Mafia. This is an anthology of Letizia Battaglia's extraordinary photographic work, from 1971 to 2016. A large selection of her iconic black and white images are published here, showing viewers one of post-war Italy's darkest periods.

Nel mondo di oggi, c'è un aumento generalizzato della mobilità come requisito richiesto dal sistema; che, poi, a sua volta, si fa tratto identitario della vita personale. Esso prende, alle volte, le forme della singleness; altre, quelle

La differenza di genere è più marcata riguardo alle priorità di vita: lavoro, amicizia e sfera sesso-affettiva. Quest'ultima è centrale per tutti; ma assume per le donne accenti più critici rispetto agli uomini. Profili paralleli? In emersione, poi, si trova il fenomeno delle coppie non conviventi, che, per scelta per forza, vivono in due case e ménage separati, pur sentendosi e configurantisi come coppia. Sia singles, sia laterals sono stati indagati dall'Autrice con un approccio partecipativo, che ha privilegiato le interviste biografiche come unità d'analisi, e le testimonianze in presa diretta. La narrazione sociologica si snoda agevolmente, arricchendosi di riferimenti alla letteratura, al teatro e al cinema.

From 'shotclog', a Yorkshire term for a companion only tolerated because he is paying for the drinks, to Albanian having 29 words to describe different kinds of eyebrows, the languages of the world are full of amazing, amusing and illuminating words and expressions that will improve absolutely everybody's quality of life. Nel suo libro, Goldman ci parla di musiciste originarie di luoghi lontani ma anche di eclettiche rivoluzionarie come Grace Jones, un'artista che pur non essendo esattamente punk ha senz'altro influenzato il movimento assorbendone l'audacia liberatoria. Questo libro è un tour musicale che partendo dalle origini europee del punk allarga il suo campo d'azione fino a raggiungere una vasta dimensione internazionale. 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Matthew Thurber's Art Comic is a blunt and hilarious assault on the swirling hot mess that is the art world. Il racconto di vita che si snoda in queste pagine, appare subito denso di riferimenti a persone, luoghi, cose, sepolti nel passato e riattivati nel lavoro della memoria di Rossana: l'io narrante della storia. Si disegna, così, un "genere misto", che si sviluppa su diversi piani di realtà e d'immaginazione, dando luogo a una storia con vena autobiografica e letteraria. Ricca di lampi in avanti e all'indietro, secondo l'idea (e la pratica) del flusso di coscienza, crea suspense e suscita coinvolgimento nel lettore. L'ambientazione bucolica di quelle estati remote - comprese in un intervallo biografico di cinque anni - registra eventi e sensazioni di felicità; testimoniati dalla sbiadita, eppur viva, immagine in copertina. È l'epoca delle grandi letture, e dello studio sistematico del pianoforte, in full immersion. In un batter di ciglia, si registra un primo passaggio nella vita della ragazza: le scoperte corporee e il gioco della seduzione, con il loro fuoco intorno ai sedici anni. Poi, la narrazione si concentra sul percorso arduo verso la giovinezza: il passaggio ai diciotto anni, e oltre. Quel tempo è segnato da un incontro erotico e sentimentale importante, puro amore, al quale Rossana è costretta a rinunciare, come avveniva un tempo, quello assai lontano. E dà il tono a una serie di

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vicende, esplicite o allusive, coeve o posteriori, nell'ordine rovesciato del ricordo. Molti sono i riferimenti "finzionali", sospesi tra realtà e sogno, affioranti in ordine (apparentemente) sparso. Da Lolita a Casanova, da Anne Frank a Colette. Per antagonismo o conciliazione con l'esperienza della protagonista. Tutto questo va a ricomporre l'adolescenza di Rossana. E a farla leggere.
