Graham and Joanna Kornelsons' life has all gone according to their plan. I found it hard to fit in the academic system as a scientific philosopher, so I started the path of knowledge without the academic prison and in order to finance that I started my own companies in the USA, Germany and the Netherlands; where I eventually ended up in a German prison.
