The attempt failed but, although Hitler was tried for treason, the judge gave him a very light sentence. While in

effectively dictator of

the centre of World War II in Europe and the Holocaust. Hitler was a decorated veteran of World War I. The failed coup resulted in Hitler's imprisonment, during which time he dictated his autobiography and political manifesto *Mein Kampf* ("My Struggle").
