indigenous languages. They saw lands, peoples, plants, and animals that no outsider had ever seen before. In this enthralling tale of castaways wandering in an unknown land, Andrés Reséndez brings to life the vast, dynamic world of North America just a few decades before European settlers would transform it forever.
