The world in which we live is rapidly changing. The Bible said the time would come when people would call good evil and evil good. We are there. The church is being impacted by an onslaught of voices all saying different things. The authenticity and authority of the Bible are not only being questioned but ridiculed, often by people who claim to be Christian. Test the Spirits is based on the apostle John's admonition in 1 John 4:1: "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world." This book is not a witch hunt. It does not point fingers at various ministers, tearing apart their ministries and messages. Rather you will learn to discern for yourself the characteristics of the true and false ministries, messages, and spiritual experiences. The author has spent thirty-five years in Spirit-filled ministry and currently serves as a missionary in Papua New Guinea. He preaches and practices the gifts of the Spirit. He is totally committed to the reality and necessity of the New Testament Church in expressing the Kingdom of God in the last days.
