Southwest Asia is at the epicenter of zooarchaeological research on pivotal changes in human history such as animal domestication and the emergence of social complexity. Care or Neglect?

This book presents the results of the archaeological activities and specialistic studies carried out at the site of Abu Tbeirah (Nasiriyah, Province of Dhi Qar, southern Iraq) by the Iraqi-Italian joint mission of the Iraqi State Board of Antiquities and Heritage and of Sapienza, led by F. D’Agostino and L. Romano (Dipartimento - Istituto Italiano di Studi Orientali). In the volume the accomplishments of the first seven campaigns (2011-2016) are introduced together with an assessment of the palaeo-environment and landscape surrounding the site. After an introduction to the reasons that led to start the archaeological activities in Abu Tbeirah, written by HE Dr A. Al-Hamdani, Minister of Culture of the Republic of Iraq, the diggings in the south-eastern Area 1 are presented (the cemetery and the other activities identified immediately under the top-soil and the last phase of Building A). A preliminary assessment on the Early-Dynastic III/Akkadian Transition pottery horizon (2450-2150 BC) is presented as well. At the same time, the multifaceted analyses and studies, carried out on Abu Tbeirah’s site and findings, are included in the volume.

Lo scavo che si è presentato estremamente complesso nella stratigrafia e nelle strutture, ha restituito un fecondo patrimonio fittile, litico e di oggetti d'ornamento: particolarmente ricca è anche la documentazione riguardante il sistema di sussistenza, l'ambiente esterno e i resti funerari umani: grazie alla generosa e paziente opera di molti collaboratori esterni, i quali, pur non partecipando direttamente allo scavo, hanno messo a disposizione la loro esperienza e competenza, è stato possibile affrontare le tematiche relative all'ambiente antico e di dare corpo e conferma alle ipotesi sull'utilizzo della grotta. Ad essi si devono i contributi del volume. All'introduzione geologica fanno seguito una breve storia delle indagini nella grotta e l'illustrazione della stratigrafia e della strutture, quindi gli studi sul materiale fittile, l'industria litica, sui resti archeobotanici, archeozoologici, antropologici e sulle componenti mineralogiche delle ceramiche. La documentazione delle sezioni stratigrafiche maggiormente significative correda il capitolo sulla Morfologia: peraltro senza il paziente e puntuale lavoro di sintesi operato da Nicola Bruni e Anna Riva non sarebbe stato possibile condensare con la

necessaria chiarezza le successioni stratigrafiche, avendo a disposizione un numero altissimo di prodotti grafici disparati.

The articles in this volume provide examples of different approaches currently being developed on Prehistoric collective burials of southern Europe, mostly focusing on case studies, but also including contributions of a more methodological scope.

Il volume correda un breve percorso espositivo a pannelli (testi e immagini) per presentare i risultati delle ricerche e degli scavi svolti dal 2011 ad oggi nel sito archeologico ‘Antiche Mura’ di Jesolo. ‘In limine’ è una poesia di Eugenio Montale (introduce la raccolta ‘Ossi di Seppia’). Il titolo, e la poesia stessa, sono sembrati pertinenti a sintetizzare il senso del progetto archeologico sull’ antica Equilo, di cui si pubblicano in questo volume i primi risultati. ‘In limine’ significa ‘sulla soglia’: indica cio è un punto di passaggio, un confine; e, nel nostro caso, metaforicamente rimarca il discrimine tra passato e presente, il luogo archeologico dove la materia inerte diviene narrazione. Qui, in limine, è anche uno spazio fisico preciso, quello dell’ area delle ‘ Antiche Mura’, luogo anche tangibile della memoria collettiva. Un luogo, ieri come oggi, ai margini. Se l’ antica Equilo era stato un insediamento sul confine instabile tra mare e laguna, la moderna Jesolo, che ne ha ereditato il nome, ha lasciato che i ruderi della sua memoria restassero al di fuori del centro abitato: nel punto dove la città diventa campagna, lì sorgono le rovine dell’ antica cattedrale, lì rimane il reliquiario della comunità , come una sorta di giardino ‘dove affonda un morto viluppo di memorie’ (di nuovo Montale). Gli archeologi hanno cercato nel tempo di recuperare quelle memorie e quel passato, con pazienza e fatica. Così , il progetto nato qualche anno fa per iniziativa del Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell’ Universit à Ca’ Foscari di Venezia, non costituisce che l’ ultimo atto di un percorso che ha inizio dalla metà del secolo scorso, con gli scavi nell’ area della cattedrale e nel vicino sito della chiesa di San Mauro. I contributi che si pubblicano in questa circostanza raccontano e sintetizzano i risultati degli ultimi anni di scavi. L’ interconnessione tra le varie strategie di indagine ci ha consentito di proporre una ricostruzione storico-insediativa del sito del tutto inedita e sorprendente.
