That is to say, at the identical time when the child was born and the Chicago clocks pointed to 15 minutes after 8 o'clock in the morning, the Observatory clock at Greenwich showed 15 minutes past 2 o'clock in the afternoon. This latter is the time we must use to make our calculations of the planets' places, and in order to avoid factors in mind as possible the beginner is advised to forget the local time of birth when once he has found the G. M. T. In Western longitudes the G. M. T. may advance into the next day on account of the addition of 4 minutes for each...
