Several mazes are also included in the book as a fun way to promote visual motor skills, eye-hand coordination, and problem-solving skills. Young students are introduced to the letters of the alphabet in exercises that have them trace Lowercase Alphabet and then practice writing them on their own. Numbers are also presented in an engaging way, with a lesson in phonetics as well as exercises for tracing and writing numerals. A section of connect-the-dot games provides more motor skills development along with helping children learn the order of alphabet, while fill-in-the-blank games reinforce alphabet learning in a different way and provide more practice in writing the missing letters.
