It was not until the middle of the nineteenth century that Carl Ludwig, Hermann von Helmholtz, Emil DuBois-Reymond, and Ernst von Brücke inaugurated a physicochemical approach to physiology in which it was recognized clearly that one set of laws must govern the properties and behavior of all matter, living and nonliving. . The task of a biologist is like trying to solve a gigantic multidimensional crossword fill in the right physical concepts at the right places. The biologist depends on puzzle: to the maturation of the science of physics much as the crossword solver depends on a large and correct vocabulary. The solver of crossword puzzles needs not just a good vocabulary but a special vocabulary.
