The computer model consists of three major parts: steady state computer simulation, optimization, and extended period simulation. The steady state simulation portion computes flows and pressures in pipe networks under steady state conditions. The optimization portion optimally sizes pipes in a water distribution system and selects optimal pipes for cleaning and lining. The extended period simulation or time simulation
