The file is updated monthly and contains monthly cost data. Twenty-one programs make up the CCCS. These programs perform such functions as sorting, printing, and updating CMF records. The system is designed to be highly interactive and user oriented, thus, numerous messages and instructions are provided throughout to aid the user. All programs are written in WANG VS BASIC and file indexing is provided by the WANG VS Data Management System (DMS).
