High fidelity simulation (HFS) is a useful method to teach practical information without the risk of harming a live patient. It is a teaching method used in at least half of all nurse anesthesia programs, but not generally designed to specifically focus on pharmacology content. Similarly, there is no research that specifically explores the use of HFS to

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supplement didactic pharmacology education in nurse anesthesia. Because of this, we designed a study to investigate the impact that HFS has on the pharmacologic knowledge acquisition and retention of student registered nurse anesthetists (SRNAs). This pilot study recruited fifteen SRNAs to participate in a pharmacology curriculum that included a traditional didactic lecture supplemented with a pharmacology focused HFS experience. Their baseline pharmacologic knowledge was assessed with a pretest that indicated no significant difference in the scores ( $p=0.34$ ). After the simulation, all participants scored 20% higher on knowledge assessment questions related to pharmacology content that was supplemented with simulation and 1% lower on the

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content that was taught via the traditional didactic lecture alone (p

Traditionally, the principles and practices of anesthesia have been taught using seminars

and lectures to supplement clinical training. There is no substitute for case-based experience; however, recent innovations in computer technology provide high fidelity, realistic simulators, which are being used in many anesthesia programs. Research using simulation technology analyzes its use as an evaluation tool in the assessment of competence and human performance; however, there is a need



to better define the role for simulation-based programs in professional nurse anesthesia education. The purpose of this study was to evaluate the effectiveness of integrating the anesthesia patient simulator with the traditional lecture in nurse anesthesia education. The study measured the potential benefits of knowledge assimilation and retention using the human patient simulator

**(HPS) in an anesthesia pharmacology course compared to the traditional classroom approach. The sample group for this study consisted of GSN nurse anesthesia students enrolled at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, Maryland. Outcome measures included the completion of a twenty item pre-test to measure each student s baseline knowledge prior to participating in a 1.5-**

hour pharmacology  
teaching session.  
Knowledge retention was  
measured by the results  
of each student s  
20-item post examination  
scores. Comparison data  
of the pre and post-  
examination scores  
within each teaching  
group was analyzed using  
a paired t-test. An  
independent t-test was  
used to statistically  
analyze the absolute  
difference in learning  
between using Likert  
type items, and  
additional open-ended

items, exploring student expectations, course strengths and weaknesses, and recommendations for future courses.

Knowledge equivalence was shown in the two groups, with baseline pretest scores showing no statistic.

TIVA trainer, the EuroSIVA meetings and online registration for these meetings. The EuroSIVA is currently engaged in friendly contacts with the Asian Oceanic Society for Intravenous Anaesthesia (AOSIVA), the United Kingdom Society for Intravenous Anaesthesia (UKSIVA), the Korean Society for Intravenous Anaesthesia (KSIVA), the European Society of Anaesthesiology (ESA) and the International Society for Applied Pharmacology (ISAP).

Although the perioperative care of patients by anesthesiologists draws on diverse clinical skills, the principles of anesthesiology and pain management are rooted in the

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neurosciences. The Neuroscientific Foundations of Anesthesiology thoroughly examines the anesthetic modulation of the central, peripheral, and autonomic nervous systems and will help redefine anesthesiology as a fundamentally neuroscientific field. The book is organized by sections, with each focusing on a different part of the nervous system.
