The extreme anti-Western actions and attitudes of Iranians in the past decade have astonished and dismayed the West, which has characterized the Iranian positions as irrational and inexplicable. Marcello Di Cintio prepares for his “journey into the heart of Iran” with the utmost diligence. He takes lessons in Farsi and Persian poetry and sharpens his wrestling skills by returning to the mat after a gap of some years. Everywhere he leads him, he discovers that poetry is loved and quoted by everyone from taxi-drivers to students. His engagement with the culture is intimate: he wrestles (sometimes reluctantly) when invited, samples illegal home-brew alcohol, attends a wedding, mourns, learns a new way to drink tea and attempts to observe the Ramazan fast, though not a Muslim himself.
