Conservation of architecture - and the conversation of Modern architecture in particular – has assumed new challenges. Rather than attempting to return a Modern building to its resumed original state, the challenge of these proceedings is to revalue the essence of the manifold manifestations of Modern architecture and redefine its meanings in a rapidly changing world of digital revolution, worldwide mobility and environmental awareness. This volume aims to provide a variety of platforms for the exchange of ideas and experience. A large, international group of architects, historians, scholars, preservationists and other parties involved in the processes of preserving, renovating and transforming Modern buildings has been invited to investigate the paradox of the Modern monument, and to reflect on the manifold dilemmas of change and continuity. The general theme is elaborated through five sub-themes. The sub-theme ‘Change and Continuity’ addresses the tensions between change and continuity from a historical-theoretical perspective. ‘Restructuring Cities and Landscapes’ focuses on the larger scale of city and landscape, while ‘Shifts in Programme and Flexibility’ draws attention to the scale of the building or building complex, and questions limits of re-use and flexibility. The fourth sub-theme deals with education and the fifth sub-theme ‘Progress, Technology and Sustainability’ considers specific issues of techniques and materials.

Located in the heel of the Italian boot, the Salento region was home to a diverse population between the ninth and fifteenth centuries. Inhabitants spoke Latin, Greek, and various vernaculars, and their houses of worship served sizable congregations of Jews as well as Roman-rite and Orthodox Christians. Yet the Salentines of this period laid claim to a definable local identity that transcended linguistic and religious boundaries. The evidence of their collective culture is embedded in the traces they left behind: wall paintings and inscriptions, graffiti, carved tombstone decorations, belt fittings from graves, and other artifacts reveal a wide range of religious, civic, and domestic

practices that helped inhabitants construct and maintain personal, group, and regional identities. The Medieval Salento allows the reader to explore the visual and material culture of a people using a database of over three hundred texts and images, indexed by site. Linda Safran draws from art history, archaeology, anthropology, and ethnohistory to reconstruct medieval Salentine customs of naming, language, appearance, and status. She pays particular attention to Jewish and nonelite residents, whose lives in southern Italy have historically received little scholarly attention. This extraordinarily detailed visual analysis reveals how ethnic and religious identities can remain distinct even as they mingle to become a regional culture.

The third International congress of Science and Technology for the Conservation of Cultural Heritage, TechnoHeritage 2017, was held in Cadiz, from 21 to 24 May 2017, under the umbrella of the TechnoHeritage network. TechnoHeritage is an initiative funded by the Spanish Ministry of Economy and Competitivity dedicated to the creation of a network which integrates CSIC and University groups, private companies and end users such as foundations, museums or institutions. The network's purpose is to foster the creation of transdisciplinary (and not only multidisciplinary) initiatives focused on the study of all assets, movable or immovable, that make up Cultural Heritage. A high-quality scientific programme was prepared, which includes new emerging topics on Cultural Heritage (1) Nanomaterials and other Products for Conservation, (2) New Technologies for Analysis, Protection and Conservation, (3) 20th Century Cultural Heritage, (4) Significance of Cultural Heritage. Policies for Conservation, (5) Deterioration of Cultural Heritage, (6) Biodeterioration: Fundamentals, Present and Future Perspectives and (7) Underwater Cultural Heritage. A special session "Biodeterioration: Fundamentals, present and future perspectives, a session in honour of Prof. Cesáreo Sáiz Jiménez" took place. Our intention was to recognise the work of Prof. Sáiz Jiménez, who recently retired, and its impact on the Cultural Heritage conservation community, which he has helped to promote through numerous activities including, in 2011, the creation of the TechnoHeritage network. This volume publishes a total of eighty-three contributions which reflect the state of the art investigations on different aspects of cultural heritage

conservation.

[Italiano]: Il presente lavoro nasce con un duplice obiettivo: andare più a fondo nella conoscenza di un caposaldo urbano e al tempo stesso contribuire a delineare per esso uno scenario futuro adeguato al suo valore, a partire da un corretto recupero delle multiformi e pregiate architetture che lo compongono. La necessità di approfondimento ha riguardato azioni e temi plurimi: esaminare il retroterra del progetto della Mostra d' Oltremare, individuato nei nuovi studi non soltanto nel dibattito cittadino su un adeguato spazio per le esposizioni da collocarsi preferibilmente ad occidente, ma anche in interessanti e autoriali soluzioni preliminari, finora sconosciute, che hanno condizionato la conformazione definitiva; mettere in luce la specificità dei singoli elementi del complesso, sopravvissuti o scomparsi, senza limitarsi ai casi più noti e celebrati, ma anche a quelli meno indagati e più difficili da interpretare, senza trascurare gli spazi aperti e il verde; approfondire anche quelle architetture non interpretabili nella linea della modernità, e tuttavia ugualmente emblematiche di quella fase, per cui meritevoli di conservazione; non limitare l' attenzione alla fase eroica, ancorché discutibile, della prima fondazione, ma analizzare con la medesima acribia anche quelle successive, a partire dalla problematica ricostruzione e risignificazione del Dopoguerra; non arrestarsi alla pur vasta ricognizione sistematica di fonti indirette finora non indagate – dai tanti archivi, a scala non solo cittadina ma nazionale, ai quotidiani e alla stampa coeva – ma interrogare con metodo scientifico le stesse consistenze materiali degli edifici; infine, non direzionare lo sguardo solo sul passato e sulla storia della Mostra e delle singole architetture, ma proiettarlo sul futuro individuando le migliori strategie di recupero, restauro e conservazione./[English]: The present work was born with a twofold objective: to go deeper into the knowledge of an urban landmark and, at the same time, to outline a future scenario aligned to its value, starting from a proper

recovery of the multiform and valuable architecture that compose it. The deepening arises from the need to study multiple actions and themes: to examine the background project of the Mostra d'Oltremare identified in the new studies, not only in the city debate on a suitable space for exhibitions to be preferably located to the west, but also in authorial preliminary solutions, until now unknown, which have conditioned the final conformation; to highlight the specificity of the single elements of the complex, the survived and the disappeared ones, without limiting the study to the best known and most celebrated cases, but also to the less investigated and difficult to interpret ones, without neglecting the open spaces and the green areas; to deepen also those architectures that cannot be interpreted in the line of modernity but equally emblematic of that phase, therefore worthy of preservation; not limiting attention to the heroic, albeit debatable, phase of the first foundation, but analyzing with the same acumen the subsequent ones, starting with the problematic reconstruction and redefinition of the post-war period; not stopping at the systematic reconnaissance of indirect sources that have not been investigated until now - from the many archives, not only on a city but also on a national scale, to the newspapers and the press of the time - but questioning the same material consistency of the buildings with a scientific method; finally, not focusing only on the past and on the history of the Exhibition and of the single architectures, but projecting it into the future by identifying the best strategies of recovery, restoration and preservation.

Il tema affrontato risulta cruciale: quali sono i limiti della responsabilità etica e professionale del restauratore architetto e ingegnere negli interventi di conservazione del patrimonio storico? L'ARCo, nei suoi venti anni di vita, ha inteso offrire uno spazio di ampia discussione e di libero confronto sui temi della conservazione e del restauro del patrimonio storico internazionale. Patrimonio di meravigliosi tesori, complesso, ricco e sfaccettato nel quale il tessuto dell'edilizia storica minore deve essere parte integrante da tutelare e conservare anche contro specifici interessi economici e politici, e per il quale l'Associazione sta sempre di più sottolineando la preoccupazione per il crescente rischio di depauperamento e distruzione. Questa situazione si riflette sulle difficoltà che i professionisti incontrano nell'esercizio della professione. Il convegno è stato quindi un'occasione per fare il punto e confrontarsi, anche con i colleghi dell'Accademia di Francia, su quali siano i margini della responsabilità nei confronti della norma, delle condizioni finanziarie e sulla conduzione a regola d'arte degli interventi di restauro; quale sia lo spazio del progetto e delle responsabilità contenute nell'assunzione di determinate scelte. Il volume raccoglie gli atti del Convegno "Responsabilità nella Conservazione del costruito storico" organizzato dall'ARCo in collaborazione con l'Accademia di Francia a Roma, il 29 e 30 novembre 2010 a Villa Medici, in occasione del ventennale della fondazione dell'Associazione.

**"In the royal and princely courts of Europe, artworks made of multicolored semiprecious stones were passionately coveted objects. Known as pietre dure, or hardstones, this type of artistic expression includes paintings in stone, which were composed of intricately cut separate pieces that were made into magnificent tabletops, cabinets, and wall decorations. Other works included vessels and ornaments carved with virtuosic skill from a single piece of rare and brilliant lapis lazuli, chalcedony, jasper, or similarly prized substance; exquisite objects such as boxes, clocks, and jewelry; and portraits of nobles sculpted in variously colored stones. Derived from ancient Roman decorative stonework, the art of pietre dure was developed in Renaissance Florence, where the manufacture of such objects was enthusiastically sponsored by Medici princes. From Italy the medium spread across Europe to Prague, Madrid, Naples, Paris, and later Saint Petersburg. Precious and fragile, pietre dure objects are rarely brought together in large numbers. This richly illustrated catalogue contains more than 150 masterworks from across Europe, dating from five centuries, including almost every artistic use of semiprecious stone during this time as well as some of the finest examples of the medium. Not only was he very close to Diderot - of whom he was biographer and editor - but he was also a privileged witness of the countless political, social and cultural events that led to the French Revolution. Besides being a convinced atheist, a tireless publisher, a fine connoisseur of Clandestine literature, Naigeon had the opportunity to collaborate in writing the last volumes of the Encyclopédie and to participate in the propagation of heterodox, materialistic and fiercely anti-clerical writings. After the Revolution - at the beginning of which he tried in vain to make himself heard by the Assemblée Nationale - he was then integrated into the "official" culture through the election at the Institut de France: however, even if he is the author of some prestigious works, Naigeon remains exclusively the living testimony of a now unrepeatable cultural season.

**The book provides a series of reflections on the study of architectural preexistences that have matured during the almost thirty-five years of study and research in Italy and Europe. Furthermore, it shows how the discipline of restoration of monuments is all based in architecture, intended in its many-faceted meanings. The methodical approach to the restoration of historic architecture consists in the historical-critical analysis, central nucleus of the study of architecture and is composed by specific in-depth thematic sessions (the historical iconography; the analysis of the constructive features; the constructive model; the volumetric layout; metrological and proportional analysis; the theme of the figurative model; the analysis of masonry; the theme of decorations; spolia and reemployed; comparisons, analogies and differences; the reading of the architectural organism through the synthesis of the monument in time). The author and his team have collected thematic essays on key issues that have great interest not only in Italy but also abroad. From the general concepts to examples of the application of Italian consolidated restoration methodology to the analysis and conservation of historic architecture.**
