Women from remarkably diverse religious, social, and political backgrounds made up the rank-and-file of anti-abortion activism. Throughout, Haugeberg explores important questions such as the ways people fused religious conviction with partisan politics, activists' rationalizations for lethal violence, and how women claimed space within an unshakably patriarchal culture.
