This volume brings together a selection of revised papers, originally presented at ICHoLS IX (São Paulo/Campinas). The papers in the first section deal with studies ranging from the Latin model in post-Renaissance grammars to new scientific propositions at the turn of the 19th century; the second part carries articles devoted to a variety of topics in 19th and 20th century linguistics; and in the third section are united papers based on plenary presentations, ranging from ancient Greek reflections upon language to developments in Brazilian linguistics beginning with the implantation of structuralist work by Joaquim Mattoso Câmara (1904-1970) in the 1960s. In the concluding contribution, a survey of advances in the history of the language sciences is offered.

Teaching Foreign Languages: Languages for Special Purposes is a collection of essays which will appeal to teachers of modern languages no matter the level of instruction. The essays deal with three main approaches of the teaching of languages for special purposes in Europe, Asia and Africa: theoretical linguistics (lexis: French vocabulary; and semantics: French copulative verbs); descriptive linguistics (compared linguistics: English - Romanian, English - Serbian, French - Romanian, French - Serbian, and German - Macedonian); and applied linguistics (language acquisition: English in Romania and Spanish in Serbia; language education: Arabic in Italy, English in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Iran, Malaysia, Russia, Serbia, and the United Arab Emirates; German in Serbia; lexicography: English, French, Romanian, Ruthenian and Serbian; stylistics: English, French and Spanish; and translation: English, Italian and Romanian).

Cette configuration des savoirs impliqués en didactique permet de rendre compte des problèmes que posent les activités grammaticales (chap. 3 à 6), la sélection des éléments à enseigner (chap. 6 et 7), les discours grammatical (chap. 8) etes progressions (chap 9). Cet ouvrage vise à suggérer des directions de recherche dans la

perspective de la contextualisation de la didactique des langues.

Cette Histoire de la langue française, depuis ses origines jusqu'aux variétés du français actuel, traite conjointement de l'histoire externe du français (événements politiques et culturels, mutations sociales, institutions comme l'Académie française, rôle des organismes officiels) et de son évolution interne (prononciation, graphie, morphologie, syntaxe, vocabulaire). Elle décrit les systèmes du bas-latin, du français de l'époque médiévale, du XVIe siècle, de l'époque moderne. Une place particulière est accordée aux codifications orthographiques, à la grammaire, à la rhétorique et à la réflexion sur le langage.
