

Le Budget De La Justice Justice Gouv

The new Edition of the report of the European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice (CEPEJ), which evaluates the functioning of the judicial systems in 45 Council of Europe's member states and an observer state to the CEPEJ, Israël, remains in line with the process carried out since 2002. Relying on a methodology which is already a reference for collecting and processing a wide number of quantitative and qualitative judicial data, this unique study has been conceived above all as a tool for public policy aimed at improving the efficiency and the quality of justice. To have the knowledge in order to be able to understand, analyse and reform, such is the objective of the CEPEJ which has prepared this report, intended for policy makers, legal practitioners, researchers as well as for those who are interested in the functioning of justice in Europe.

En 1997, la dépense de justice par habitant était, en Allemagne et au Royaume-Uni, respectivement 1,52 et 1,49 fois plus élevée qu'en France, un écart qui s'est creusé au cours de la période considérée ici, 1990-1997. La recherche sur les budgets de la justice en Europe, coordonnée par le professeur Étienne Douat à la demande de la Mission de recherche " Droit et Justice ", ne s'arrête pas à ces résultats aussi spectaculaires qu'inédits. Les données officielles, vérifiées et validées dans chacun des six pays retenus (Allemagne, Belgique, Espagne, France, Italie et Royaume-Uni), révèlent d'importantes différences structurelles dans les budgets de la justice qui, au-delà de la diversité des systèmes juridiques et judiciaires, des héritages culturels et historiques, traduisent des choix politiques, des conceptions de la fonction de la justice. Le Royaume-Uni octroie beaucoup de crédits à l'aide juridictionnelle, l'Italie aux détenus, la France à la protection judiciaire de la jeunesse ; l'Allemagne compte 2,48 fois plus de magistrats professionnels par tranche de cent mille habitants que la France... Le présent rapport rend possible une véritable comparaison européenne sur des points aussi essentiels que le salaire des magistrats, le financement de l'aide juridictionnelle, le budget des prisons, l'origine et l'évolution des dépenses de justice.

This "Liber Amicorum" is published at the occasion of Judge Lucius Caflisch's retirement from a distinguished teaching career at the Graduate Institute of International Studies of Geneva, where he served as Professor of International Law for more than three decades, and where he has also held the position of Director. It was written by his colleagues and friends, from the European Court of Human Rights, from universities all around the world, from the Swiss Foreign Affairs Ministry and many other national and international institutions. The "Liber Amicorum Lucius Caflisch" covers different fields in which Judge Caflisch has excelled in his various capacities, as scholar, representative of Switzerland in international conferences, legal adviser of the Swiss Foreign Affairs Ministry, counsel, registrar, arbitrator and judge. This collective work is divided into three main sections. The first section examines questions concerning human rights and international humanitarian law. The second section is devoted to the international law of spaces, including matters regarding the law of the sea, international waterways, Antarctica, and boundary and territorial issues. The third section addresses issues related to the peaceful settlement of disputes, both generally and with regard to any particular means of settlement. The

Throughout Europe, judicial systems are under an increasing societal and political strain to increase the speed of proceedings, to improve their organisational functioning, and to pay attention to the media and the public. As a consequence European governments have recognized the necessity to invest in their judicial systems, since they perform a growing role in the democratic life and an essential task in upholding the rule of law. This difficult challenge of change can not be left only to the juridical professionals that traditionally have the domain on judicial systems. The contribution of public administration scholars will be important to develop a body of knowledge that can endorse this challenge and combine insights from different perspectives. This collection wants to stimulate further developments of public administration studies in the field of justice. These contributions describe various attempts that have been made in the different countries to cope with the increasing political and societal demands to the justice system. They reveal many existing tensions between traditional legal professional values, in particular judicial independence, and pressures to increase productivity and effectiveness of the work of the courts and public prosecutors' offices. Accountability and legitimacy of the courts are at stake here as well. Attention is also being paid to the consequences of the introduction of Information and Communication Technologies in judicial organisations.

Lord Slynn of Hadley is one of the outstanding judges of his time. He has served as a High Court Judge, as an Advocate General and a Judge of the European Court of Justice, and he has been a Lord of Appeal for ten years. This Liber Amicorum bears testimony to the international reputation that he has achieved for his judgments and for his scholarship. Les problèmes de la justice ont fait irruption à plusieurs reprises, ces derniers temps, au premier plan de l'actualité. La plupart d'entre eux, cependant, sont de vieilles connaissances. La refonte de la carte judiciaire, le surpeuplement des prisons, les taux de récidive alarmants ont figuré bien souvent déjà à l'ordre du jour ; et les revirements de la politique pénale - entre libéralisation, durcissement, innovations - jalonnent les deux derniers siècles. C'est cette histoire mouvementée d'une institution républicaine conservatrice que l'on a voulu retracer ici, en prenant comme fil conducteur l'histoire du budget de la Justice. De la Révolution de 1848 à la Libération, de la Commune de 1871 à l'instauration de la République, les grands événements de notre histoire politique ont presque tous laissé une empreinte visible sur les chiffres du budget. Mais l'approche budgétaire témoigne aussi et surtout d'une tension permanente entre besoins et ressources financières, qui fait obstacle à toute réforme d'envergure. Alors que l'"encellulement" des prisonniers était déjà sous la Monarchie de Juillet au cœur des débats sur le régime pénitentiaire, l'objectif minimum d'assurer une cellule individuelle à chaque détenu en maison d'arrêt paraît toujours aussi difficile à atteindre au seuil du XXIe siècle.
