I was defensive and furious with myself. #3 The Navy's counter-terrorism unit, DEVGRU, was born in the aftermath of the 1980 mission to rescue American hostages in Iran. The unit has grown significantly and filled out with numerous teams of operators as well as support staff. #4 I was the only one in my platoon going to the screening process. I was in poor physical condition, and I knew the first part of the screening was a fitness test. I easily passed the push-up test, despite the instructors' nitpicking each rep.
