Taking a fresh approach, this study stresses the destabilising effect of Whitehall's demands for power and money, which increased rapidly in the quarter century before 1642. The careful calibration of the burden of the state on the local community illustrates the surprising vitality of the early Stuart regime and the political origins of the Civil War.
