"Nineteen Eighty-Four: A Novel", often published as "1984", is a dystopian social science fiction novel by English novelist George Orwell. It was published on 8 June 1949 by Secker & Warburg as Orwell's ninth and final book completed in his lifetime. Thematically, "Nineteen Eighty-Four" centres on the consequences of totalitarianism, mass surveillance, and repressive regimentation of persons and behaviours within society. Orwell, himself a democratic socialist, modelled the authoritarian government in the novel after Stalinist Russia. More broadly, the novel examines the role of truth and facts within politics and the ways in which they are manipulated. The story takes place in an imagined future, the year 1984, when much of the world has fallen victim to perpetual war, omnipresent government surveillance, historical negationism, and propaganda. Great Britain, known as Airstrip One, has become a province of a totalitarian superstate named Oceania that is ruled by the Party who employ the Thought Police to persecute individuality and independent thinking. Big Brother, the leader of the Party, enjoys an intense cult of personality despite the fact that he may not even exist. The protagonist, Winston Smith, is a diligent and skillful rank-and-file worker and Outer Party member who secretly hates the Party and dreams of rebellion. He enters into a forbidden relationship with a colleague, Julia, and starts to remember what life was like before the Party came to power.

The Trueba family embodies strong feelings. This family saga starts at the beginning of the 20th century and continues through the assassination of Allende in 1973.

Pero no, no es ficci ó n: cartas, pasaportes, fotograf í as, actas de nacimiento, certificados escolares y m á s documentos reales integrados a la narraci ó n toman por el cuello a los lectores para someterlos de forma implacable.

« Necesito tratar con buenas personas » , dice el joven pr í ncipe Lev Nikol á ievich Myshkin al llegar a San Petersburgo, despu é s de pasar cuatro a ñ os en un sanatorio suizo trat á ndose el « mal caduco » . Apenas tiene dinero y su ú nica esperanza es una pariente muy remota, Lizaveta Prof ó fievna Yepanchin á , casada con un general retirado y madre de tres hijas. El mismo d í a de su llegada es un c ú mulo de incidencias: desde la acogida – mezcla de curiosidad y suspicacia – que le dispensa su lejana familia hasta una noche de esc á ndalo y humillaciones en casa de una bella mujer de mala reputaci ó n, Nastasia Fil í pповna, cercada por varios pretendientes. Se encuentra de pronto, en fin, arrojado al acontecer, en medio de « una gente extremadamente rara » , como un eremita obligado a socializar. Con su candidez e inconsciente indiscreci ó n, a lo largo de la novela no dejar á n de llamarlo « idiota » , pero tambi é n « artista » , « enfermo » , « loco » , « ni ñ o » ; y algunos creen que es un tipo astuto que esconde alg ú n as bajo la manga. Escrita despu é s de Crimen y castigo y antes de Los demonios, de nuevo en un largo per í odo de

penurias, El idiota (1868-1869), que aquí presentamos en una nueva traducción de Fernando Otero Macías, inicia el ciclo final de obras maestras de Dostoievski. Como ellas, ha propiciado múltiples lecturas, pero sigue siendo la más enigmática e imprevisible de todas.

El cuarto volumen de la colección Historia de las Merindades está dedicado a las Siete Merindades de Castilla (Castilla Vieja, Sotoscueva, Valdeporres, Montija, Valdivielso, Losa y Cuesta Urria), que hoy conforman 12 ayuntamientos. Las Siete Merindades mantuvieron durante la Edad Media sus jurisdicciones en el sentido territorial y jurídico, no formaron parte de las donaciones reales. La zona estudiada en esta obra estuvo marcada por

un importante desarrollo en el periodo del Hierro I (en torno al año 600 a.C.) esa organización dejó su rastro en la composición de las jurisdicciones supraaldeanas. El Hierro II nos deja importantes castros que dominan cada uno un territorio menor, ya se dibujan lo que serán las jurisdicciones supraldeanas altomedievales. El periodo romano dejó su impronta en los campamentos y zonas de batalla de las Guerras Cántabras, en la ocupación de la explotación minera de Salinas de Rosío, en la villa romana de Losa y en un buen número de asentamientos rurales y estelas sepulcrales. La ocupación visigoda se descubre en el centro de este marco territorial, en el entorno de Trespaderne y Cillaperlata. La Alta Edad Media, (segunda mitad del siglo VIII al siglo XI) nos ofrece las primeras noticias escritas de las jurisdicciones de este territorio y los elementos defensivos que los organizaban. Las noticias se multiplican a comienzos del siglo XI de manera geométrica ofreciendo datos de la ocupación poblacional y de sus asentamientos (defensas, monasterios, eremitorios, poblados). En la Plena Edad Media comenzó el declive poblacional de las Siete Merindades lo que dio lugar a la reorganización del territorio por impulso real (Alfonso VII y Alfonso VIII). Las Siete Merindades mantuvieron durante la Baja Edad Media sus jurisdicciones en el sentido territorial y jurídico, no formaron parte de las donaciones reales. Únicamente lo fue el puesto de Merino Mayor que se administraba en nombre rey. Tratamos la evolución hist...
