The "Lexicon Grammaticorum" is a comprehensive reference book that provides information on the lives and work of all scholars and thinkers throughout the world who have concerned themselves down the ages with the study and description of language. The "Lexicon" contains articles on more than 1,500 representatives of the world's linguistic traditions, written by 422 authors from 27 countries. Generally, an article consists of a biography, an abstract of the linguist's achievements, including his or her influence, and a two-part bibliography, listing first his or her writings, then those about him or her. Whenever possible, the references are complete; where the works are too numerous for them all to be listed, as is often the case with more recent linguists, only the main titles appear, with references to already existing bibliographies. The aim of the "Lexicon" is twofold: namely to provide access to the history of linguistics through its most important representatives and to combine the world's diverse linguistic traditions in one book, thus showing what is individual and is universal in human thought about language.

Through a combined methodology of philology, social theory and archaeology this book offers a reinterpretation of Statius's *Silvae*.

The contributions contained in this volume offer a multidisciplinary approach into the history of the parts of speech and their role in building phrases and sentences. They fulfill a current interest for syntactic problems for combining recent linguistic theories with the long tradition of the Classical studies. The studies cover a chronological range reaching from Aristotle to Priscian and deal with concepts like *ἰσοπλάθει* and *ἰσοπλάθει*, or the two Aristotelian expressions *ἰσοπλάθει* and *ἰσοπλάθει* as well as *ἰσοπλάθει* and *ἰσοπλάθει* in Apollonius Dyscolos and the corresponding Latin term *transitio* and finally the Latin pronouns *qui* or *quis*. Through the metalinguistic approach the authors tackle syntactic structures like dependency or government, syntactic features or properties such as transitivity or subject and predicate or the development of the syntactic role of pronouns in introducing relative sentences. Furthermore, in providing testimonies of the historical existence of the controversy anomaly-analogy, the history of this quarrel is drawn from the Alexandrian tradition to the Latin one with emphasis on the *studium grammaticae* as a development of an independent field of study.

In addition to many revisions of the text, the Second Edition also includes new units on cultural context, tied to the narrative content of the chapter.
