Implicit within this summary are the profession's core beliefs in the positive relationship between occupation

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and health and its view of people as occupational beings. Numerous resource materials include a glossary, references and a bibliography, as well as a table of changes between the editions.

Motivation is key to substance use behavior change.

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Counselors can support clients' movement toward positive changes in their substance use by identifying and enhancing motivation that already exists. Motivational approaches are based on the principles of person-centered counseling.

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Counselors' use of empathy, not authority and power, is key to enhancing clients' motivation to change. Clients are experts in their own recovery from SUDs.

Counselors should engage them in collaborative partnerships.

Ambivalence about

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change is normal.

Resistance to change is an expression of ambivalence about change, not a client trait or characteristic.

Confrontational approaches increase client resistance and discord in the counseling relationship.

Motivational

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approaches explore ambivalence in a nonjudgmental and compassionate way. Learning disabilities are among the most common disabilities experienced in childhood and adulthood. Although identifying learning disabilities in a school setting is a complex

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process, it is particularly challenging in low- and middle-income countries that lack the appropriate resources, tools, and supports. This guide provides an introduction to learning disabilities and describes the processes and

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practices that are necessary for the identification process. It also describes a phased approach that countries can use to assess their current screening and evaluation services, as well as determine the steps needed to develop, strengthen, and build systems that

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support students with learning disabilities.

This guide also provides intervention recommendations that teachers and school administrators can implement at each phase of system development.

Although this guide primarily addresses learning disabilities,

disabilities commonly
encountered in
