Sur fond de relations hiérarchiques, de rapports de force, de rivalités ou d'affinités, un moment se dessine - entre désir et refoulement, prise de risque et frustration - où tout devient possible. De belles histoires naissent, moins nombreuses toutefois que les moments d'égarement sexuel sans lendemain. « Ça » se passe au bureau, au parking, dans l'ascenseur, dans le secret d'un cabinet médical, à l'hôtel, lors d'un entretien d'embauche ou d'un déplacement, après un déjeuner ou un dîner qui ont créé les conditions du passage à l'acte, brusqué, consenti. Ou pas... Promotion-canapé assumée, respiration anti-routine, drague lourde, romantisme fleur bleue, démon de midi, exploitation de la naïveté humaine... le sexe dans le cadre professionnel a mille facettes. À l'opposé d'un énième essai sociologique sur le monde de l'entreprise ou d'une vision d'expert des rapports humains, L'amour au bureau donne la parole à des « vrais gens » qui témoignent sans tabou de leur expérience, encouragés par la méthode de l'auteur : un entretien en toute liberté et sans fausse pudeur, une relation de confiance entre enquêteur et interviewé(e), de l'humour, de l'émotion, aucun jugement. Ce livre réunit, sous forme d'entretiens, les témoignages de personnes ayant vécu une expérience

sexuelle ou amoureuse sur leur lieu de travail. À PROPOS DE L'AUTEUR Docteur ès Lettres de l'Université Paris-Sorbonne, Rodolphe Fouano est auteur et journaliste. Il collabore à différents supports dont Challenges et L'avant-scène théâtre où il traite de sujets sociétaux et culturels qui déclinent l'art de vivre. Après La Tentation libertine (La Boîte à Pandore, 2018), voici sa seconde enquête consacrée aux questions de sexualité.

Electronic version: Free PDF available About the publication Africa's increasing recognition and protection of human rights have been accompanied by a surge in the number of NHRIs established with broad mandates to promote and protect human rights. The mandates and powers of the NHRIs vary from country to country, as does their ability to deliver on these mandates. Indeed, the rapid increase in the number of NHRIs in Africa has come with a variety of substantive and operational challenges. In the face of such challenges, those who work in NHRIs need to understand the broader regional and global context in which the institutions operate and the changing nature of human rights issues. This compendium provides an overview of NHRIs in eastern and southern Africa. It is guided to a large extent by the internationally agreed-upon Principles Relating to the Status of National Institutions, referred to as the Paris Principles. These Principles are broadly accepted as the benchmark against which the legitimacy and credibility of NHRIs can be assessed. Endorsed by the United Nations General Assembly in 1993, the Paris Principles provide NHRIs with guidelines as to their competence and responsibilities, their composition and guarantees of independence and pluralism, and their methods of operation; additional principles relate to the status of commissions with quasi-judicial competence.
