Through skillful innovation and manipulations of both genre and media, Philostratus' Imagines explores the potential roles of art within elite society. Written in the early third century CE, the Imagines is a series of sixty-five ekphrastic descriptions of paintings on display in a suburban Naples villa. As the first text to elevate ekphrasis from a rhetorical adornment and establish it as its own genre, the Imagines remains an invaluable resource for exploring the intersections of ancient visual and literary cultures. Previous scholarship on the Imagines has focused mainly on two aspects: the rhetorical interplays between art and text and the role of the viewer reception of paintings via Philostratus' descriptions. In this dissertation, I argue that Philostratus' ekphrases present a complicated venue for discussions of elite acculturation or paideia and its cultural expression. The sophist's innovate use of models drawn from visual art and the materiality of the paintings works in tandem with his deep understanding of the Hellenistic literary tradition to demonstrate that paideia functioned as a multifaceted value system promulgated through a variety of media. Furthermore, not only Philostratus' use of intertextual allusions but also his engagements with material culture show that the Imagines constructs a rich network of examples intended to reinforce the elite ideals and cultural memories at the heart of paideia.
