known today that Ares was worshipped by the warlike Spartans, but since they created very few grandiose works of architecture or literature (compared to those that came out of Athens), Sparta's views on Ares, and most other deities they worshipped, are paltry. Athenian culture, on the other hand, dominated the ancient world's art and culture, and its influence was felt strongly in the beloved myths and histories of the epoch. For better or

Although Athens left literary and archaeological evidence of their preferences for civic worship, many other poleis (Greek city-states) were

There's little of the "War God" in any of his stories other than the odd mention of how
